3. Rope for Gallows Point Woods – Councillor J Zalot will organise
4. Arrangements with Golf Club. A gate needs to be opened, a length of fencing temporarily removed and the route marked. - Councillor C Brimecombe will speak to Golf Club
5. Ladders over Cefn – Mr Will Williams will provide.

2. A minibus to bring people (e.g. stragglers) back from locations along the walk would be useful.
3. Some form of commemorative map could be produced showing the route and location of the main events could be published.
