12.0 EVENTS

12.1 BEAUMARIS IN BLOOM – WALES IN BLOOM

The Town Clerk said that Councillors needed to decide whether or not the town entered the competition this year.

A Councillor mentioned that the original Committee started on the work in November and a lot of work was required to prepare for the competition.

The Town Clerk stated that all the contractors were aware of the requirements for entry this year.

A discussion took place.

It was proposed, seconded and carried unanimously that the town should not enter the competition this year.

It was proposed, seconded and carried unanimously to delegate authority to the Town Clerk pending formation of the new Council to ensure all the flower display borders are maintained this year.

12.2 BEATING OF THE BOUNDS

The Town Clerk provided an update in relation to the arrangements and confirmed that the office was arranging the event.

Councillors asked questions to the Town Clerk.

12.3 JUBILEE

The Town Clerk stated it had been agreed that a tree be planted at Happy Valley.

The Mayor reported on a meeting with representatives from the town in relation to the town celebrating the Jubilee. She said there was guidelines online as to celebrating the event.

A discussion took place.

It was proposed, seconded and carried unanimously that the Town Council has a Queens Platinum Jubilee beacon with associated activities, and the Town Clerk has power to act in relation to matters.

It was proposed seconded and carried unanimously to permit a tea party at Happy Valley.

It was proposed seconded and carried unanimously to attempt to have Mayor's Sunday on Sunday 5th June to coincide with the Jubilee celebrations.

It was proposed seconded and carried unanimously for the Town Clerk to investigate the cost of a big screen and a potential suitable location for the four days.

12.4 MAYOR’S SUNDAY

It was agreed that the possibility of having Mayor’s Sunday on the 5th June 2022 had been discussed above.

13.0 CASTLE SQUARE EVENTS AND MARKETS COMMITTEE – UPDATE

The Town Clerk reported that the first meeting was in October and the Committee is starting to consider the applications received. But in the last fortnight more interest has occurred because there are improvements in relation to Covid restrictions. She explained that the Committee had been advised from the Monitoring Officer in holding a meeting in the next week.

She confirmed that the Press Release from Anglesey County Council regarding the Square and Committee was only released at the beginning of the month, even though it had been prepared months earlier.

It was reported that committee members had organised the vigil for Ukraine that had taken place that evening prior to the meeting.
