THE PERAMBULATION OF THE TOWN BOUNDARY

BANK HOLIDAY MONDAY, 02 MAY 2022

The Ceremonies, which are associated with Rogationtide, ie the blessing of the land, its fruits, industry, and with leisure, as well as demarcating the boundary of the town, will commence at 9.30.

A procession will form up of all those participating outside the Town Hall, headed by the Town Band and led by the Town Mayoress, Councillor Rhian Aledwen Jones, and members of Beaumaris Town Council, to proceed to divine Service.

After which, the Town Mayoress and members of Beaumaris Town Council will proceed to the Pierhead, when a stone will be cast into the Menai Straits as a reminder of the jurisdiction of the town of Beaumaris and its former Corporation over the harbour and its waters.

The Perambulation of the Boundary, led by Mr Will Williams, will then commence from the landward side of the Pier, moving along the shore towards Cemetery Hill.
