35.0 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor I Davies declared a prejudicial interest in item 37.0 Additional CCTV Cameras as an employee of North Wales Police.

36.0 TOUR OF BRITAIN – PARKING AND OTHER ARRANGEMENTS

Resolved by majority: To charge £3 for parking on the Green during the event.

Councillor C Theakston joined the meeting

Resolved nem con: To agree to the proposed road closure (Alma Street to Green Edge).

Resolved nem con: To give the Town Clerk powers to act to organise the parking on Castle Meadow. The Town Council wished it to be an arrangement between the Town Council and Baron Hill Estate.

37.0 ADDITIONAL CCTV CAMERAS

Councillor I Davies left the meeting

The Town Clerk outlined the current position and some additional proposals:

1. Position a camera to cover the archway
2. Purchase an additional camera to cover the Green exit barrier
3. Link the existing cameras at the attendants hut to the system (but to exclude them from the link to North Wales Police).
4. Provide cover of the main Green.

The estimated cost of the additions is about £5300 of which £1000 can be offset by the saving from not having a camera at the Post Office.

Resolved nem con: To go ahead with the additional spend.

38.0 OTHER URGENT MATTERS

38.1 Town Hall Safe

Resolved nem con: To agree to proposals for works to open the jammed safe at an initial cost of £350. Additional spend may be required depending on work involved.

38.2 Banners on the Pier

The Town Clerk outlined an alleged trespass by advertising banners into the paddling pool area.

Resolved nem con: To take steps to remove (or have removed) the banners.

38.3 New drains on Green Road

Anglesey County Council are concerned that work on the new drains cannot start until October. They have asked to meet a delegation from the Council to discuss.

Resolved nem con: To not agree to meet the County Council but to explore a possible compromise start date immediately after the Food Festival.
