**1.0 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

**2.0 TO CONSIDER DONATION REQUESTS:-**

**2.1 CAB Food Bank**

Members were circulated with the letter requesting donation from CAB. The Town Clerk explained that an application form had not been filled in. A member was concerned that this request was for a service that was outside our ward. The Town Clerk explained that we can make a donation if it serves our community under the Wellbeing Act 2000 against Section 137.

**Recommendation to Council:-**

The Council agree to donate £500. The Town Clerk to contact CAB and ask them to complete the Application Form, so that it can be ratified at the next Finance & Planning meeting.

**2.2 Seiriol Alliance Good Turn Scheme**

Members were circulated with the application form. The Town Clerk proceeded to give an outline of the request and also stated that the organisation have been successful in obtaining a Grant of £3,878 from Anglesey Charitable Trust. A Member stated that the scheme had carried out over 700 good turns over the last 6 weeks and has over 110 volunteers to date.

**Recommendation to Council:-**

It was proposed and seconded to donate £2,500 in the first instance and that the Town Council will accept a second application later in the year should the Seiriol Alliance required a further donation.

**2.3 Canolfan Iorwerth Rowlands**

Members were circulated with the application form.

The Town Clerk gave an outline of the request and the current financial situation of the Canolfan.

Recommendation to Council: -

It was proposed and seconded that due to the Town Council having a reduced income and the financial position of the Canolfan, the Town Council is unable to support the application on this occasion but would be willing to consider an application in November.
