



BEAUMARIS TOWN COUNCIL GREEN PARKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Parking is for cars, motorcycles and other light vehicles. Vehicles over 3500kg are not permitted.
2. Vehicles must be taxed, insured and roadworthy.
3. Vehicles must not be parked so as to cause an obstruction.
4. The Green is intended for temporary parking of vehicles that are in regular use on the road. Long term storage or the placing of vehicles for advertising purposes is not permitted. Motorhomes and caravans must be unoccupied overnight (21.00 – 08.00).
5. Vehicles must be driven carefully and with due care and attention at all times. The speed limit is 10mph. Vehicles must not be driven over the flood bunds surrounding the green.
6. Vehicles are parked entirely at the owner's risk. The Council does not accept any liability or responsibility for any loss or damage while vehicles are parked on The Green.
7. The Green is covered by CCTV. Anyone parking a vehicle consents to us capturing, using and processing their registration number and personal details. CCTV footage may be used to identify vehicles and owners and to investigate incidents. If requested we will provide information and copies of recordings to the police and insurance companies. The Town Council does not guarantee that all parts of the green or all incidents will be covered by CCTV.
8. Beaumaris Green can flood if spring tides combine with onshore winds. Anyone parking overnight is advised to subscribe to Natural Resources Wales's flood alerts: <https://naturalresources.wales/flooding/flood-warning-service>.
9. Vehicles must display a valid parking ticket or permit. These are:
 - Day parking tickets. Available from attendants or the coin operated machine.
 - Annual permits. Available for residents of Beaumaris and regular visitors. Passes must be fixed to the windscreen of the vehicle for which it was issued and are not transferrable. Failure to display a valid permit will result in parking charges being applied.
 - Contractor Passes. These allow parking in the 'Stones Area'.
 - Weekly permits. Available for visitors staying in and around Beaumaris.
10. Barrier cards are available to permit holders to allow them to open the barrier when the Green entrance is unattended. Possession of a barrier card does not give the right to park.
11. A permit does not guarantee a parking space. The Town Council reserves the right to direct vehicles to park in specific places, close all or part of the green, to suspend permits and vary charges for special events (including charging permit holders).
12. Parts of the green may be closed to parking from time to time. Pass and ticket holders must comply with any instructions about where parking is permitted.
13. The Town Council reserves the right to refuse entry, cancel a permit or require a vehicle to be removed if it appears that these conditions are not being complied with.
14. The Town Council reserves the right to move or have moved any vehicle that is causing an obstruction or hazard, appears to be stolen or abandoned. Before moving a vehicle The Town Council will make reasonable efforts to contact the owner or permit holder. The Town Council will not be liable for any damage caused.
15. Vehicles must not be towed on to the green. The filling or discharge of fuel is not allowed.
16. No one is allowed to sleep or stay in any vehicle overnight (21.00 – 08.00).
17. A ticket or permit gives permission to enter and leave The Green by the designated entrance and exit and to park. No other rights are granted.
18. No activity in connection with the selling, hiring or other disposal of vehicles or goods or services may be carried out on the green without prior specific written permission.
19. These terms and conditions cannot be varied except in writing by the Town Clerk. Nothing said or done by any employee or member of the Town Council is capable of varying these terms.
